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


Welcome Back to another season! As we turn the house lights down and raise the curtains for more stellar performances this year, we take a moment to appreciate the arts.




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THE STANLEY THEATRE THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE THE SHOW!

DOUGLAS DAY STEWART (*Co-Author of* in the Stathe Book and Original Screenplay). Douglas Digest, p Day Stewart is best known for his original Theatre,

screenplay An Officer and a Gentleman, which was based on his own experiences as a Naval Officer Candidate in 1965, undergoing rigorous training while dating a local factory girl. In addition to the many accolades and awards garnered by the film, "Officer" was recently listed by the American Film Institute as one of the ten highest grossing love stories in cinema history. A medical problem would knock Stewart out of his dream to fly jets but he would go on to serve on a top-secret team of Naval and Marine officers that sent the entire population of Marines at Camp Pendleton to Vietnam, thus ending the United States' "police action" and starting "The Vietnam War." Other writing credits include the enduring first Blue Lagoon with Brooke Shields, the acclaimed The Boy In the Plastic Bubble (the ABC television movie that launched John Travolta's career), and *The Scarlet Letter*, take on Hawthorne's classic novel, starring Demi Moore. Stewart wrote and directed the cult favorite Thief of Hearts (which boasts clubs of devoted women around the United States) and the controversial *Listen to Me*, about college debaters forced to take both sides of the abortion issue. Stewart has been nominated for an Academy Award, an Emmy, and for numerous Writers Guild Awards. He is the father of three, sons Dylan and Sean, and daughter Shady. He is married to artist Judith Gersten. Stewart has recently completed his screenplay An Officer and a Gentleman - The Final Act, the longawaited sequel to his original, which will go before cameras this year, starring the original actors along with a young leading lady who will play Zack and Paula's daughter as she relives her father's journey from the first film.

SHARLEEN COOPER COHEN (Co-Author). Sharleen Cooper Cohen began as a highly successful interior designer. She wrote seven published novels: The Day After Tomorrow, Repeat Performance, The Ladies of Beverley Hills, Marital Affairs, Love Sex and Money, Lives of Value and Innocent Gestures (over two million in print: U.S., Italy, Spain, Norway, Sweden, China, The United Kingdom.) Three optioned for film and television. Theatre projects Sheba, (book, lyrics, co-producer) music by Gary William Friedman, produced Off-Broadway 91st Street Playhouse one of their most successful shows, an excellent New York Times review and Honorable Mention in the Stage Play Script Category, Writer's Digest. Coast premiere of Stormy Weather starring Leslie Uggams was produced at The Pasadena Playhouse, held over by popular demand, broke all box office records. Production is planned for 2022. 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
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

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

Seat Talking is a new series inspired by loyal, long-time Broadway Utica subscribers. Their stories highlight the reasons why they made the wise decision to become subscribers while giving theater lovers an inside look at the person occupying a seat to the left or right of them.

Deep in the center of the orchestra in row M seats 105 & 106, you'll find Rick and Wendy Short, engrossed in conversation, laughter, and life among their theater neighbors.

"Wendy and I have been subscribers for many years. Those years have included a rewarding series of seat upgrades, eventually landing us in seats beside long-time friends. Seeing people in this personal setting, apart from work, makes relationships richer and broader. It's a great benefit to wonderful productions."

Forming a relationship with those around them, one where the chatter of activities, tales of vacations, and new shows are exchanged, has become an added perk of the Broadway Utica lifestyle. Yet, the real treasure comes as the lights begin to dim, silence fills the crowd, and they ease back into the soft, velvet seats reflecting on their admiration for the theater.

"I went to West Canada Valley Central School in the 1970s. We were blessed to have a music teacher, Mr. David Reardon, who staged musicals annually," Rick recalled. "I think every single student was captivated by the magic of his productions. He gave us the gift of being involved as stagehands, actors, musicians, or just as the audience. I vividly remember sitting on the edge of my 7th-grade seat being utterly captivated by Camelot. After that, life became unimaginable without musicals."

Rick and Wendy first joined Broadway Utica to ensure that art, music, and time together were always a part of their lives.

"In the beginning, Wendy and I were thrilled to be able to afford a subscription. Any seats were exciting for us. Then over time, we upgraded our location to the point where we wouldn't think of changing seats."

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
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
